What is this project about?

A survey on management and managers in the Italian public hospitals

- Measuring management practices «WMS/MOPS HP» style
- Understanding who hospital managers are attitudes, skills, traits

 Linking these measures to hospital-level healthcare outcomes and to admin data on managers' CVs

Why do we care?

Large variation in healthcare outcomes across Italy

- Management and managers are an important input for the production of healthcare
 - Cf. the whole Bloom Sadun Van Reenen literature

Little is known about italian public hospitals

What do we want to do?

Measuring

Management practices in hospitals + attitudes/skills/traits of managers at different layers of government

- and possibly the perceptions of workers on the same matters
- Two (+1) surveys
 - Directors of ASL / ASL public hospitals & Aziende Ospedaliere
 - Heads of Units (primari) multiple ones within given hospitals
 - (Workers)
- Linking the data with admin data on manager CVs and healthcare outcomes (AGENAS PNE)

Questionnaire structure

Managers

- A. Demographics
- B. Tenure and mobility
- C. Job satisfaction
- D. Knowledge of policies

Management

- E. Management control
- F. Human resources management
- G. Healthcare policies (risks management, waiting times, accreditations)

Where do we stand?

- Questionnaires for Directors and Heads of Units are ready
- Currently programming the survey instrument for testing
- We gathered contact information for all hospitals
- We contacted with two survey agencies (IPSOS & Demetra)
- Currently working on means to incentivise participation
 - Institutional support
 - Testimonials
 - Donations (€€€)
 - Proxy interviews delegation
